Principals update, Ms. Joanna

- Curriculum shifts this year adopting Science of Reading (see newsletter), Wit + Wisdom
- We have a new Recess Coach, Coach Destiny from Asphalt Green, Mon-Thurs, who leads children in organized, collaborative games; participation is optional
- School budget is very tight, new curriculum adoption is very expensive

Afterschool update, Ms. Pamela

- 6 crickets is our afterschool communications platform and the place to make any changes related to afterschool
- Staff rotates so the staff at pickup points can change every day; anyone picking up your child needs to be noted in 6 crickets as an approved pick up person
- If you want to make change of membership type email Pamela by the 1st of the month
- If want to change any specialty programs email Kate Gitnick
 - there may be some specialty programs that have space
- If your child will not attend afterschool on a particular day, let their teacher know. Or if they are attending on a day they don't normally attend, please call the office

- Aftershcool will not pull children out of programs during program time. If you need to pick up your child early, contact Pamela in advance; you can pick up your child before their program time or after, but not during. Pamela's phone: Google voice 347-994-9555
- Homework hall is timed quiet time for children to work on their homework (it is not tutoring); if you prefer your child do their homework at home or some portion thereof, contact Pamela via email
- Children will never be forced by staff to do homework at afterschool; a note will be sent home in folder if child does not want to do homework
- If child has a 2 hour specialty program, they will not have homework time that day
- Looking to add more programs for kindergarten; there is greater number of kindergarteners enrolled in afterschool this year than previous years
