- Fall Festival neted \$16,665 profit!
- Budget Highlights:
 - Anticipated income \$352K
 - Anticipated expenses \$339K
 - Anticipated overage \$12K
 - Largest incoming funds:
 - Fundraising events \$78K
 - Direct Donations \$225K
 - Largest expenses:
 - Professional development for teachers/staff, \$25K
 - Staffing / DOE shortfall, \$180K (includes part time science teacher, etc)
 - Enrichment programs: art, library, math, science, \$8K
 - School Support, \$21K
