Principal Update

- -Lunch: Menu is likely to change in coming days due to supply chain issues. Please be patient.
- **-Parent teacher conferences:** Nov 4th and the school day will end at 11:40. There will be no afterschool on this day.
- **-Report cards: They are coming early, Nov 4th.** Please know that 107 understands this is very early in terms of assessments. Kids are adjusting well! Notes on Grading scale, etc. to come.
- -Special Education recovery services: Parents with IEPs, the city is looking at the need for services at school either in the morning or afterschool.
- **-Covid safety:** We continue to have 0 covid cases at school. Thanks for getting kids tested regularly and keeping kids home when they are ill.
- --Lunch: Kids are still eating outside. Please dress your kids in layers. Sweaters and fingerless gloves are a great idea.

Change to the healthcare screener: If your child does have covid symptoms, in order to return to school, the school will need a PCR test or the child must adhere to the ten day quarantine.

Parent Coordinator Update:

- **-Housekeeping:** Every parent should have a schools account NYCSA. This is for all attendance, test scores, attendance and fitnessgrams will be posted here for your observation. Other forms are also located there such as IEP, covid forms, transporting, etc. Initiate setting up this account on your own or ask Pamela for assistance.
- **-OSIS-** Is your student ID. This can be found in your NYSCA. It will be required to fill out forms during students' NYC public schooling.
- **-Your child's NYCDOE email**: Your child will need this to access their google classroom. This will be needed November 4th for asynchronous learning that day. Please set this up. If you need help, ask your teacher or ask Pamela.
- **-Lunch form**/ **Economic Survey:** Every family must fill this form out. This needs to be filled out every year even if you don't qualify for free lunch. Myschoolapps.com
- **-Lost and Found:** Label your gear or it is difficult to return. *Come in with a photo ID and fill out the health screener to access the lost and found racks.*

Media consent forms: This needs to be filled out every year and is required by the DOE. Request sent via Operoo. **Picture day is Monday.** It will happen outside. The photograper will remain 10ft away from the kids. Class photos will take place this year, but masks will have to stay on. Retake, Tuesday Nov 30th but there won't be a class photo that day. If you don't like your photo, participate on reatake day. Retouching available as well.
