# Principal update, Ms. Joanna

- Armory: Much of the drill floor at the Armory closed for repairs; Ms. Joanna in regular contact with Y Director; still using the remaining floor for PE; safety is being continually assessed, though if necessary, Park Slope Jewish Center is potentially a back-up option.
- PS 107 designated a "No place for hate" school: designated by ADL; Goal is to educate students about impact of words and actions and to educate about and reduce microaggressions.
- Recess: New recess coach has started, Coach Todd; participation is optional; recess coach has brought structure and calm to recess time.
- Lunch: Occasionally late period lunches run out of certain items; if your child experiences this please report to Nadia so that kitchen manager can better plan.
- Dogs near school: Please do not leave your dogs tied to the fence at pick up or drop off for either school or after school.

## **Council Member, Shahana Hanif**

- Prioritizing education budget; school budgets have been slashed and her office will advocate to keep schools fully funded; Per Ms. Joanna, PS 107 does not receive adequate funding from DOE for basic necessities, which PTA has to fund. Cuts will further reduce ability to provide full services.
- CM Hanif is Chair of immigration cmte. Focus on helping support migrant students with bilingual educators and resources; new shelter opening soon in Gowanus area that will need support.
- Street safety is ongoing focus.
