### Principal Update, Ms. Joanna

- Report cards will be sent out Jan 30th via NYC schools account
- There will not be parent-teacher conferences aligned to report cards; teachers will have limited availability to discuss pressing issues with parents

- Student attendance is a major focus of DOE this year as attendance for many students has dropped since Covid; an attendance rate less than 90% is considered chronic absenteeism, while less than 80% is considered severe.
