- COVID Updates (3:15-3:40)
- Current covid cases as of 12/15, 2 students, 2 related service providers. School exposure was outside and close contacts quarantined.
- Protocols have been revisited- outdoor lunch for rest of the week of dec 15. Sit upons are a hit!
- Cafeteria has added seating to make spreading out easier, additional seating in halls
- Testing will be encouraged within the community.
- Quarantine rules + Vaccination status (81% of students are vaccinated, 368 have had at least one dose)
- Fully vaccinated students will not have to quarantine if they are identified as a close contact. Quarantine only required for those showing symptoms. Currently 10% of unvaccinated students are tested- this week 8 students were tested.
- % of vaccinated students affects the amount of testing done at school- it reduces testing.
- Local SLTS are advocating for more testing
 - Working with other SLTs to get additional testing for schools- 10% of entire school population, regardless of vaccine status would be our goal

Parent SLT group will investigate a mobile testing van to come to school site when school starts again during break. We may also sponsor one at our sister school

Afterschool is updating protocols for snack to move snack outdoors + review social distancing protocols to ensure that all measures are being met.

Close contact parameters: child to child 3 feet, masked. Child to adult, 6 feet and one party unmasked. If a teacher or para in classroom tests positive, the entire class will be quarantined.

Will vaccinated students be notified if they are close contacts? -- YES!
