Directions

- 1. Beginning Thursday, February 15th and ending Sunday, March 4th, students use their "Home Reading Log" to track the number of minutes of reading completed each day. (Extra Home Reading Log forms are available at www.ps107.org/readathon.) We ask Parents/Guardian to please verify each day's reading by initialing on the line for that day. Assigned reading counts too! Parent/Guardian assisted reading allowed for K and 1st grade readers.
- 2. Add up all minutes read, figure out what each sponsor owes you and collect your pledges. All "Home Reading Logs," "Donor Forms" and donations must be handed in by Friday, March 9th, 2018. (Extra Donor Forms are also available at www.ps107.org/readathon.)

Rules

PARTICIPATION: All students enrolled at PS 107 are eligible to participate in the Read-A-Thon. The Read-A-Thon runs from Thursday, February 15th through Sunday, March 4th. All reading completed during that time (including assigned reading) counts towards the Read-A-Thon.
